#### **Can I get a tax deduction for my contribution to the ACP?**

Yes. In France, your gift in Euros is deductible under the category “Oeuvres reconnus d’Utilité Publique ou fiscalement assimilé en matière de dons.” The ACP issues year-end receipts of giving acceptable for French tax authorities in Feb/March. If you wish your gift to be tax-deductible in the United States, you must make your check payable to our parent organization The American and Foreign Christian Union (AFCU) with the words “for ACP” in the memo line.
